Sermon Scripture: 1st Kings 18:15 – 18 (GNT)

Message Title: Go Make Some Waves!

Current/Scripture Context:

- Today we need a **conscious** and conscientious Covenant community that is dedicated to making some **waves**.
- A **troublemaker** sees what is **wrong** in the world; what's wrong in the **community**; what's wrong in the **church**, and they say, "I've got to trouble these **waters!**"
- And God is **raising** a standard of people, who aren't interested in causing **internal** trouble or being in trouble, but who are **bold** out enough to make trouble for the troublemaking **factions** in the world!

Relevant Question:

- After I've been disturbed and disrupted to make trouble, what do I need to do in order for God to use me as a wave maker?

Sermon Observations:

1. You need to know your **name!**
2. Remember that your **name** is connected to His **Name!**

Calvary Connection:

- Since your name is connected to His Name, you don't have to be **scared** of anything, because Jesus already took the **heat** out of it! When Jesus died on the **Hill**, He took the heat out of it; He was dead on **Saturday** to take the heat out of it; but early on Sunday morning He got up because He was **hooked** up to **Divinity**...so go make **waves!** Make waves against **prejudice**; make waves against **ageism**; make waves against **doubt**; make waves to bring **joy**; make waves to spread **love**; make waves to build **hope**...let's go make some waves!

Personal Reflection: How do you/we become more effective than the forces of evil at making waves that lead to positive change and growth in our communities?
