Sermon Scripture: Luke 22:31 – 32; Acts 2:1 & 14 – 21 (GNT)

Message Title: Make Your Move!

Current Context:

- The truth of the matter is that no matter what faith **faction** you find yourself in, God is calling you and **commissioning** you to make a move!
- When you decide to move, you are no longer just **free**...you become, as Paul describes, an **ambassador** in chains!
- Many people will not move because they don't think that moving is a part of their present **reality**: "I've always been here; always been like this; always been in this place"...but **moving** is in your **blood**!
- Peter, in the text, represents the essence of the believer's **existence**.
- Peter not only **loves** the Lord, but he also has some **issues**. His problems, his faults, and his lapses, though, would all be used to be a **blessing** to somebody else!
 - When he was **ready** to move, he was **responsible** for helping his brothers and sisters move as well!
- God has **chosen** you, like He did Peter, to **move**!

Relevant Question(s):

- How do you make your move?

Sermon Observations:

1. You must let God **place** you and **plant** you!
2. You must also let God **push** you!

Calvary Connection:

- We've heard other **voices**, but those voices have been **silenced**. There's another voice, however, that **booms** through **eternity** into time! A voice that was born in a **barnyard** in Bethlehem! On Friday it looked like His voice would be **silenced**; but early on Sunday morning, He got **pushed** out of the grave, and His voice **shouted**, "I've got all power in my hands!" And Jesus is still **talking** today!

Personal Reflection:

- Has God ever planted you in an uncomfortable place? How did it grow you and/or change you?
- Do you believe that God has moved, and still moves today in our lives? Why or why not?
