**Sermon Scripture:** Matthew 28:1 – 7 (Good News Translation)

**Message Title:** Let's Go Part 10: I've Got Next!

**Current/Scripture Context:**

- A problem is that many **people** live, justifiably, in **fear** about what might come next in their **lives**.
- And because of that fear, people, instead of getting **excited** about next; instead of having next on your mind, get **stuck** in now!
- The difference between now and next is that now is my **reality**, but next is my **possibility**.
- Right now the text has some deep **despair**.
- Mary, mother of Jesus, standing there **watching** her son in agony, she wasn't **thinking** about next.
- Sometimes it is hard to get to next when you're **wrestling** with the **emotions** of now.
- The good news, though, is that these two **dynamic** women decided not to **drag** their today of Friday, into their **tomorrow** of Sunday!
- So we are **learning**, through this text, to **thank** God for now, because it is a **gateway** for what's next!

**Relevant Question(s):**

- How do I go, daily, from now to next?

**Sermon Observations:**

1. Have an **indestructible hope**!
2. Have an **immutable holler**!

**Calvary Connection:**

- You know they **hung** Him high; you know they **stretched** Him wide; you know they **belittled** Him! But they made a **mistake** that **secured** our Salvation; they made a mistake that took us from now to next...they **forgot** to close Jesus' **mouth**!
