Sermon Scripture: Mark 4:35 – 41 (Good News Translation)

Message Title: The Storm Stopper!

Current/Scripture Context:

- One of the strongest tenets of the Christian faith is that God is **Omnipotent**...His power is **unlimited!**
- Something happens, though, as we **age**...we lose that innocent **confidence** that God is all-powerful!
- In the text, a **storm** shows up and the disciples **quickly** forget about their recent experiences with the Lord.
- But I believe that here we discover Jesus' ultimate **promise**. He does not offer His **followers** riches or power; He offers the **promise** of His **presence!**
- The most **powerful** words in the Christian **faith** are lived in this text, "You are not **alone!**"
- God has the power to bring deliverance; faith; **strength**; peace; joy; **teaching**; and hope through the **storm!**

Relevant Question(s):

- How do I appreciate HIS power, so when a storm shows up, I can have faith in HIS promises?

Sermon Observations:

1. God has a **poise** that **props** you!
2. God has a **peace** that **protects** you!
3. God has a **power** that **positions** you!
4. Jesus **paid** a **price** that **pardons** you!

Calvary Connection:

- In **Genesis** God made you, but at **Calvary** He bought you! In the **beginning** He made you, but at the **Cross** He bought you! Before the **mountains**, He made you; but on the **Hill** He bought you! You're **twice** His! On Friday, He **paid** the price; on Friday, He gave my **pardon!** But on Sunday, He got up and His pardon gave me **power!**
