

FBCH New Ministry Proposal Charter Template:

Proposers must complete the following standard outline:

1. PROPOSED MINISTRY NAME: (e.g., FBCH C.A.R.E. Ministry)
2. MINISTRY LEADER / INTERIM CHAIR:
3. TARGET AUDIENCE: (e.g., Young Families, Seasoned Saints, Singles, Generations, Streaming Audience, Unhoused Neighbors)
4. CORE STRATEGIC FOCUS:
 - How does this initiative serve as an incubator for spiritual growth?
 - What specific 21st-century community barrier does this ministry break down?
5. RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT PLAN:
 - Time: What is the proposed meeting frequency and core volunteer roster size?
 - Talent: What specialized skills are needed (e.g., AV engineering, counseling, event coordination)?
 - Treasure: What is the initial estimated baseline operating cost, or will it be self-sustaining?
6. FIRST 90-DAY LAUNCH PLAN:
 - Month 1: Core volunteer recruitment and training.
 - Month 2: Initial soft-launch event or service update.
 - Month 3: Full community rollout and alignment reporting.

Step 2: Clearance & Launch Milestones:

1. **Pastoral Review:** Present the completed proposal charter to Pastor Joya Moore to ensure seamless alignment with B.I.G.G. and broader church ministries.
2. **Membership Activation:** Host an information session or panel discussion during church fellowship windows to invite congregants and gauge interest.
3. **Continuous Reporting:** Every new ministry must provide quarterly impact summaries highlighting how many disciples were engaged, how many individuals were served, and how the Acts 2 model of church fellowship was advanced.
